


Grammar Introduction

	Singular	Plural	
-s	house tree	houses trees	Singular means 'one.' Plural means 'two or more.' To make most nouns plural, add-s.
-es	beach brush glass fox	beaches brushes glasses foxes	Noun ending: -ch, -sh, -s, -x Plural form: Add -es.
-les	family story	families stories	Noun ending: a consonant + -y Plural form: Change y to I and add -es.
-ves	leaf knife	leaves knives	Noun ending: -f or -fe Plural form: Change f or fe to v and add -es.
Irregular	mouse sheep woman	mice sheep women	No rules More examples: child - children foot - feet man - men
