The US police force has long been accused of brutality, for some officers use excessive force, particularly against African Americans. In May 2020, such an incident that1. in Minneapolis triggered nationwide and even international protests.  On May 25, 2020, George Floyd, a 46-year-old African-American man, was killed during an arrest. He allegedly had used counterfeit money in a store and been reported to the police. Four officers cornered him and later choked him. The whole incident was videotaped by onlookers and security cameras. Almost the whole nation went mad2. viewing the videos. People flew into a(n)3.  and the four officers involved were immediately fired and charged. The following day, the area near the location where Floyd had been killed was4. with flowers and placards. Floyd's last words, "I can't breathe," and the phrase "Black Lives Matter" went viral and became the slogans of the protests


From the National Museum of African American History and Culture all the way around the outer circle of the Washington Monument and then back to the museum to complete the protest.
