In the 1930s, discrimination against African Americans was prevalent in the United States. Black people were often treated unjustly or even 1. of bad things they had not done.

One day, in the town of Maycomb, Alabama, a well-respected white lawyer named Atticus Finch was 2. to defend a black man called Tom Robinson. Tom was brought to court on a charge of sexually assaulting Mayella Ewell, a young white woman. Although the Ewells were 3. in the community, people still stood on their side since the defendant was a black man. Furthermore, the local people could not understand why a white lawyer would defend a black defendant. They even called Atticus names. However, Atticus firmly believed a lawyer should stand up for the rights of all people, 4. of their skin color. He even taught his son to use his head instead of his 5. when dealing with conflict.

During the trial, evidence showed that Tom's 6. of the story was probably true to what had happened. 7., he was still convicted of sexual assault. Tom was plunged into 8. after the verdict was announced. Before long, he was shot dead during an attempt to escape from prison.

Though justice had not been done, Atticus noticed that prejudice against black people had begun to melt away. Generally, it took only a few minutes for a jury to find a black person guilty, but this time, the jury had discussed the verdict for several hours. This meant there 9. have been at least one member of the jury who had believed in Tom's innocence. This was 10. a sign of progress and positive change. That is, people had started to make judgments based on evidence rather than skin color.

The US police force has long been accused of brutality, for some officers use excessive force, particularly against African Americans. In May 2020, such an incident that 1. in Minneapolis triggered nationwide and even international protests.

On May 25, 2020, George Floyd, a 46-year-old African-American man, was killed during an arrest. He allegedly had used counterfeit money in a store and been reported to the police. Four officers cornered him and later choked him. The whole incident was videotaped by onlookers and security cameras. Almost the whole nation went mad 2. viewing the videos. People flew into a(n) 3., and the four officers involved were immediately fired and charged. The following day, the area near the location where Floyd had been killed was 4. with flowers and placards. Floyd's last words, "I can't breathe," and the phrase "Black Lives Matter" went viral and became the slogans of the protests that followed.

Meanwhile, the police department was confronted with strong 5.. Subsequent protests against police brutality and racism took place all over the United States. To people's 6., some police officers acted violently toward peaceful protesters and reporters. As riots broke out everywhere, over 62,000 National Guard soldiers were 7. to maintain order.

Seeing all this unrest, Terrence Floyd, George's brother, called on his fellow countrymen to stay 8.. He told them in an interview, "Don't tear up your town... if his [George's] own family and blood is not doing it, then why are you?" He said that he could understand why people 9. felt furious and that these destructive acts would overshadow his brother's memory, though. Terrence also 10. out that it is more positive to channel the fury in another way and seek justice instead.

In the wake of George Floyd's death, police chokeholds were banned by the Minneapolis City Council. So was the use of excessive force by police officers.

Meanwhile, Nick heard from Jordan that Gatsby and Daisy had been in love several years before, but while Gatsby was serving in the army, Daisy had reluctantly married Tom Buchanan.

Gatsby, still deeply in love with Daisy, asked Nick to invite her to one of his parties. 2. At the party, Daisy was surprised to see Gatsby again, and later, they fell in love again, starting an affair.

Tom soon became aware of his wife's relationship with Gatsby. 3. Gatsby requested that Daisy tell Tom that she had never loved him, while Tom revealed to Daisy Gatsby's illegal actions to make a fortune. 4. Thus, Gatsby and Daisy left the hotel, with Daisy insisting on driving to calm herself down. However, she accidentally hit and killed Tom's mistress, Myrtle. To protect Daisy, Gatsby wanted to take responsibility for the death. Later, he was shot to death by Myrtle's husband.

From the National Museum of African American History and Culture all the way around the outer circle of the Washington Monument and then back to the museum to complete the protest.

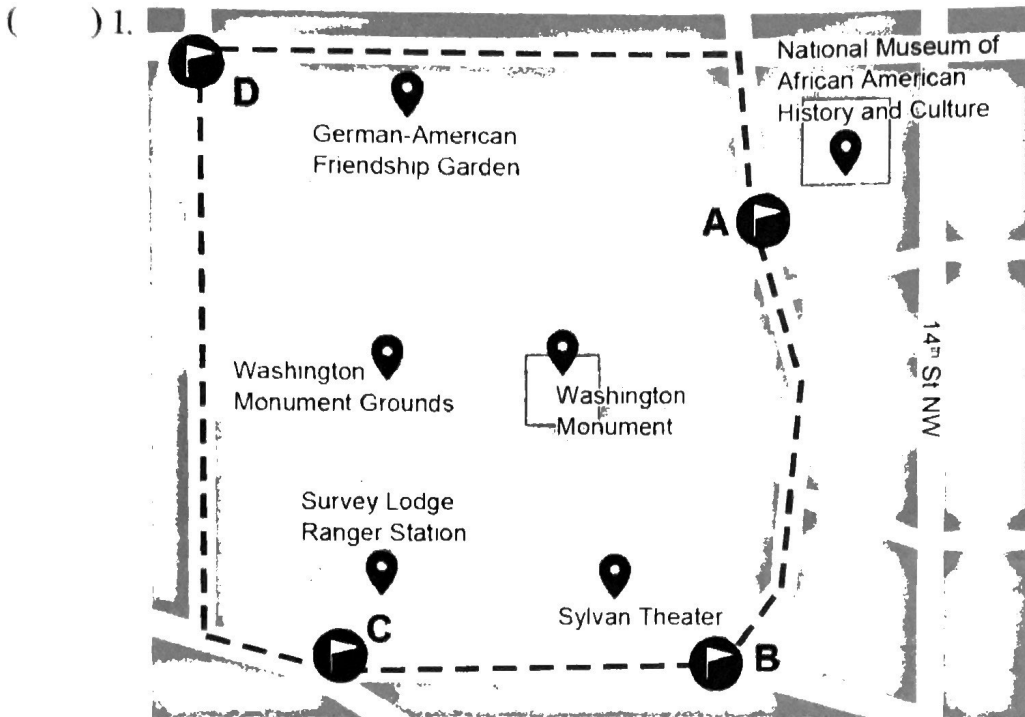
If you want to participate in our protest, please obey the following rules:
