



The Most Popular Plastic Surgery in the U.S.

Originated from medical treatments, plastic surgery can be categorized into two types: reconstructive surgery and cosmetic one. **The latter** has become more and more common among people who want to be more attractive through the procedure.

Take the U.S, for example. According to the American Society of Plastic Surgeons, in 2018 alone, there were 1.8 million cosmetic surgery procedures in the U.S., including 313,735 breast enlargement surgeries, 43,591 breast reduction surgeries, and so on. Besides, buttock augmentation with fat grafting had the highest growth rates. Compared to 2017, it had a 19 percent growth in the number (N).

With the development of medical surgery, it is possible that more and more people are willing to have plastic surgery, for better appearance and increasing self-confidence.
