
Taiwan Minbao was the most influential newspaper founded by the Taiwanese people during the Japanese rule in Taiwan. On April 15th, 1923 (Taisho 12), it was published in Tokyo and written in Chinese (previously *Taiwan Youth* magazine and *Taiwan* magazine were written in both Chinese and Japanese). Moreover, *Taiwan Minbao* was the only agency that enjoyed freedom of speech in Taiwan. It was originally a biweekly magazine which was launched on October 15th. This magazine was later published every ten days and incorporated into the Japanese version. From July 12th, 1925 (Taisho 14), it was changed to a weekly magazine, and the Taipei branch was added. Therefore, the founding of the *Taiwan Minbao* was an important achievement allowing Taiwan's new literature to be widely spread and well-known among the Taiwanese.
