For over a hundred years, many women have fought for equality. Their efforts were the beginning that started the women's movement. However, there is still much work to be done to achieve true gender equality.

In the past, women were supposed to stay at home. Although some women worked in commercial companies, most of them did traditionally "female" jobs like waitresses and maids. What's more, they were discouraged from doing "male" jobs such as doctors and pilots. In the 1970s, it became more common for women to have both a family and a career. Today, women face fewer obstacles. Nevertheless, even in some developed countries like Finland, which has special laws to promote gender equality, most nurses are women and most engineers are men. Perhaps men and women just choose different jobs because of the biological features of the male and female brain. But the way men and women market themselves probably also plays a role. In the end though, does it matter if women and men prefer doing different jobs? After all, being equal does not mean being identical.

Despite the great progress in gender equality, women still face problems such as violence, sexual harassment, and revenge attacks from men. Also, many women have to deal with disrespectful male co-workers. Another major issue is the gender pay gap, which acts like an invisible barrier. Many women have turned to social media to demand action. There are dozens of online petitions about bridging the pay gap, and the list of signatures grows daily. Several countries have reacted to these

petitions. The UK government recently planned to deal with the pay gap, but it will take years to have any effect.


Gender equality is one of the biggest social issues of our time. The fight for equality of the sexes is far from over, so it's up to us to take up the cause and continue fighting.
