





Simplelife.Hu has just returned from a 28-day volunteer tour in Cambodia. And she shares her experiences and reflections on her Twitter.

Though the construction had not been completed the day I left, I felt so happy and proud about being part of the "New Classroom Project."

We spent one month in Cambodia building this new classroom brick by brick for these kids in this remote village. Heat! Humidity! Mosquito bites! Never-ending backache! But just by looking at the expectant look and the innocent smiles on these kids' faces, all the sweat and pain paid off!

Imagine laying bricks under a 33°C scorching sun in the morning while getting soaked in a pouring rain in the afternoon! However, backed with the merry humming tunes of these lovely kids, our work became meaningful. Furthermore, seeing none of them have a decent pair of shoes, I felt regretful about not bringing some beautiful pairs of shoes for them. I used to think it impossible for me to live one single day without a convenient store. However, after 28 days in this remote village in southern Cambodia, I see one thing clear in me—I, a 17-year-old-girl, living a comfortable life in a modern city, can—and have already—step out of my comfort zone, take on challenges, and lend a helping hand to people in need.

Pretty touching photos! It looks like this tour to Cambodia has made you grow up, doesn't it? But has it ever occurred to you that such short-term "volunteer tour" as you have taken might actually do more harm to the local community?

First of all, do you volunteers know how to construct a building? Even such an easy task of laying bricks still requires professional skills. What if the building "could have been" better structured or "could have been completed in a more efficient way" if the construction work had been undertaken by local skilled brick layers? Is it possible that the volunteers are actually depriving the locals of their employment? Will the school pay money to hire the local skilled brick layers if they have volunteers to carry out the construction project for free? Which carries out the real "good intention": paying to fly to the poverty-stricken countries and contributing unskilled labor for a summer vacation, or directly donating the money to help local organizations hire professional locals to carry out the projects of and on their own?

At the end of the your weeks, volunteers like you, return to your betteroff countries, with a full sense of achievement and scrolls of touching photos and inspiring stories which have won countless "LIKES" and even envies on your social media pages. But what is left with the local people? Are they truly becoming better off after the volunteers leave? What is "real good" of the local community? Is a flash-mob Santa with a short-term presence of temporary favor or a persistent Prometheus with a consistent plan that will help the locals to run an effective system on their own?
