As the bombings and battles continue to rage at home, hundreds of thousands of Syrians have found their best chance for survival is outside their country. Unfortunately, not all members of the European Union (EU) are welcoming the refugees with open arms.

This situation shines a harsh light on the relationships among the European Union countries. Wealthy nations like Germany are able to welcome more than their fair share of refugees. The Syrian Civil War proves that some conflicts cannot be contained. When people are in danger, they will do anything necessary to bring their families to safety. The Syrian refugees deserve the world's attention. The sooner international leaders can set aside their differences, the more lives will be saved.
