The Syrian Civil War has caused a large number of refugees to flee from the country. As the bombings and battles continue to rage at home, hundreds of thousands of Syrians have found their best chance for survival is outside their country. Unfortunately, not all members of the European Union (EU) are welcoming the refugees with open arms.

This situation shines a harsh light on the relationships among the European Union countries. Wealthy nations like Germany are able to welcome more than their fair share of refugees. With better systems in place to find homes and jobs for the refugees, Germany can shoulder much of the burden. Some countries, such as Hungary and Poland, are less willing to cooperate. The Syrian refugees deserve the world's attention. The sooner international leaders can set aside their differences, the more lives will be saved.
