Among their many gods and goddesses, the ancient Greeks worshipped Athena as the goddess of wisdom and war. Athena was a daughter of Zeus and was his favorite among his many children. The legend surrounding her birth contains several peculiar details. Athena had no mother and she was never a baby. Instead, the story goes that she sprang directly from Zeus' forehead as a fully-grown woman. When she popped out, she was already dressed for battle. This fact impressed and pleased Zeus greatly. What's more, Athena's unusual “birth” put an end to the terrible headache Zeus had been suffering.

The stories of the ancient Greeks describe Athena as a fierce and clever warrior. She never ran away from danger and fought side-by-side with the bravest military heroes in the Trojan War. Perhaps not surprisingly, some of her symbols were tools of battle: a sharp pointed spear and a shield belonging to Zeus, known as the aegis. She was in charge of protecting the citizens of the great city that still bears her name today: Athens.


The ancient Greeks actually associated Athena with many other things besides wisdom and war. These included mathematics, arts, courage, strength, justice, law, and civilization itself. They believed Athena would inspire and favor those creating arts and crafts, especially those involved in the spinning and weaving of cloth. They even credited her with inventing the flute, although the goddess threw away the flute later because she was mocked when playing it, according to legend.

To express their gratitude and admiration, the Greeks celebrated Athena in poetry and songs, often referring to her as “grey-eyed.” They even held a festival called Panathenaea in Athens every



year to honor their city’s protector.

In modern times, the powers of the gods may have faded, but they remain an important part of Greece’s history and culture. As proof, temples dedicated to Athena can still be visited today, including the famous Parthenon.
