Achilles was a great hero, and he often appeared in the myths of the ancient Greeks. He was famous for his handsome appearance and his great physical strength. Achilles's father was Peleus, the king of the Myrmidons, and his mother was the beautiful Thetis. Before Achilles's birth, two of the most powerful gods, Zeus and Poseidon, had both been in love with his mother. However, the two love-struck gods didn't continue to pursue her because of a warning that the son of Thetis would one day become more powerful than his father.

One of the best-known stories about Achilles involves his mother's plan to ensure her mortal child would live forever. It had been predicted that Achilles would die as a hero in battle. To stop this from happening, Thetis took her infant son Achilles to the River Styx, which separated the world of the living from the world of the dead. Trusting the river's magical powers, Thetis dipped Achilles in its dark waters. She knew this would protect Achilles from injuries.

However, Thetis made a small error that would lead to the undoing of her plan and be the eventual cause of her son's death. When dipping him in the water, Thetis held onto Achilles by one of his feet, so no water ever touched his heel. Unfortunately, **his mother's mistake** meant Achilles's fate was sealed.

Achilles grew up to be a great warrior, and he appeared to be **indestructible**. He commanded many ships and fighting men during the Trojan War. However, when an arrow shot from his enemy Paris's bow struck Achilles's unprotected heel, the wound would prove to be fatal. To this day, we still refer to someone's greatest weakness as his or her "Achilles's heel."
