The Miss Earth contest was first held in 2001. Different from the traditional beauty contests, this contest was rewarding the girls for doing something to benefit the environment. They were judged on not only how they look, but also on their efforts to make the world a better place.

The winner went around the world to remind the public of the importance of environmental protection. She spoke for the planet and taught people how to respect the Earth. Take the winner of the 2006 contest, Hil Hernandez, for instance. As a Miss Earth titleholder, Hernandez has appeared on TV to inform people about biofuels, which produces fewer of the gases that cause global warming than normal fuels. She has also gone to supermarkets to hand out reusable shopping bags, to encourage people to cut down on the number of bags they throw away.

For beauty contests to survive in the 21st century, beauty queens will have to show that they are about more than looking good. They will have to give women credit for using their brains as much as their bodies. Miss Earth is the first contest to take this idea seriously, and maybe the other competitions will follow their lead. After all, people might agree that doing beautiful things is more important than looking beautiful.
