More and more animals are in dangers of becoming extinct. Even America’s beloved national symbol, the Bald Eagle, was facing this terrible fate. Once, Bald Eagles could be found in all of the fifty states except Hawaii, but by 1967 only several hundred remained. The Bald Eagle was put on the list of endangered species that year as the number continued to fall.

Two things were causing the reduction. In the 1940’s, American cities had been growing quickly to keep up with the increasing population. As the cities pushed further into the countryside, many trees were cut down, destroying the forests that were the habitat for the Bald Eagles.

It was also around this time that farmers began spraying poisonous chemical called DDT on their crops to control pests. Mice also ate the poison by having the crops. DDT was also seeping down into the soil and making its way into lakes and rivers, poisoning the fish. When the eagles ate the poisoned mice and fish, DDT became a part of the food chain. It caused female eagles to lay eggs with unusually thin shells, meaning many eggs never hatched. Scientists warned that unless something was done immediately to save the bald eagles, they would be lost forever.

In 1972, the United States government responded by forbidding the use of DDT. As the poison was removed from the food chain, the Bald Eagle population began to grow back. In 1974, there were only around 791 nesting pairs of Bald Eagles in the United States. By 1998, this number had gone up to around 5,948 pairs, and nowadays is no longer on the endangered species list.

Extinction is forever, and humans must do everything possible to protect the Earth’s animal species. We can learn a lot from the Bald Eagle’s remarkable success story. It shows that if people make a serious, determined effort, even the most desperate situation can be changed.
